Routine Schedule for Cleaning, Sanitizing, and Disinfecting

Federal Regulations: 1304.20; 1304.21; 130422; 1304.53; NMAC-ED 7.6.2.9D

Sanitizing: Reducing germs on inanimate surfaces to levels considered safe by public health codes or regulations. Food safe Solution = 1/2 teaspoon per 1 gallon of cool water **Disinfecting:** Destroying or inactivating most germs on any inanimate surface. Solution = 1/4
